M: Oh, hi, Kate! I'm creating a portfolio of my articles and photos.

F: Why?

M: Well, I plan to join the University Newspaper Club as a photojournalist, so I figured I'd show them samples of my work.(27) What about you? What club are you planning to join this year?

F: I decided to join the Theater Club. In fact, I'm going to their audition this Friday.

M: Really? I thought you were already a member! I've seen you perform in a couple of plays...and you were good. So, what made you decide to audition?

F: I've always wanted to join because I love acting, but I was too scared of embarrassing myself at the auditions and being rejected.(29) That's why I tried other theatrical groups, first.

M: Don't worry. I'm sure you'll be accepted.

F: I hope so. I have a friend who tried out for the Theater Club last year. She told me how her audition went. First, they asked her to sing and dance. Then, they made her act out different kinds of roles and portray various emotions. The most difficult exercise was when they told her to act like a hungry tiger ready to pounce on her prey. M: That's sounds like fun! Maybe I'll attend the auditions, too, just to have a good laugh.

F: Yeah, I bet you would. Anyway, another reason I'm joining is that I'd like to learn other things aside from improving my acting skills...things like how to direct plays, write scripts, and manage the technical side of things, like lights and sounds. Knowing how to do those things will be very useful to me, especially because we will be making a lot of video productions for most of my classes.(31)

- F: I'm sure they will. And you're right; you will learn a lot of different things in the club. My classmate, Paul, is a photographer for the paper. He told me that aside from his main duties, he usually helps with the layout of the paper. Sometimes, he even spends the night in their office just to finish an issue's layout.
- M: Really? I wouldn't mind doing that. I love doing layouts and computer graphics.
- F: The best part is the university gives him a discount on his tuition just because he works for the paper. He also gets paid for the work that he does on each issue.(32)
- M: I knew about the discount, but I wasn't aware that you get paid for the work, too.
- F: You do. Paul said that they treat you like a professional. The payment depends on how many pictures he takes and how many pages he works on.
- M: Wow! That's just great! Now I really hope I get in.
- F: I'm sure you will. Hey, I'd better go now. I have a study group to attend.
